### **Project Description**

The Government of the Republic of the Philippines through the Subic Bay Metropolitan Authority (SBMA) has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (World Bank) towards the cost of Second Subic Bay Freeport Project for the Subic Bay International Airport Improvement Project (SBIA-I-Subic II). The project involved, among others, the construction of additional aprons (concrete overlays), and drainage system, and water and sewer facilities. The Subic Bay International Airport Improvement Projects aimed to improve access into and within the Freeport, to minimize the impact of the projected increase in passenger and freight traffic brought about by the rapid development of the Subic Bay Freeport Zone as center for industry and tourism, and to enhance transport safety and Freeport security. In order to meet the objectives for these impacts, an "Airport Improvement" project has been proposed consisting of the Apron Extension which involved the construction of additional pavement, drainage relocation, relocation / expansion of the existing apron lighting system and ancillary works.

### **Scope of Work**

Trans-Asia undertook consultancy services for the Construction Supervision and appointed as the Project Manager who supervised the execution of the Works and administering the Contract.
