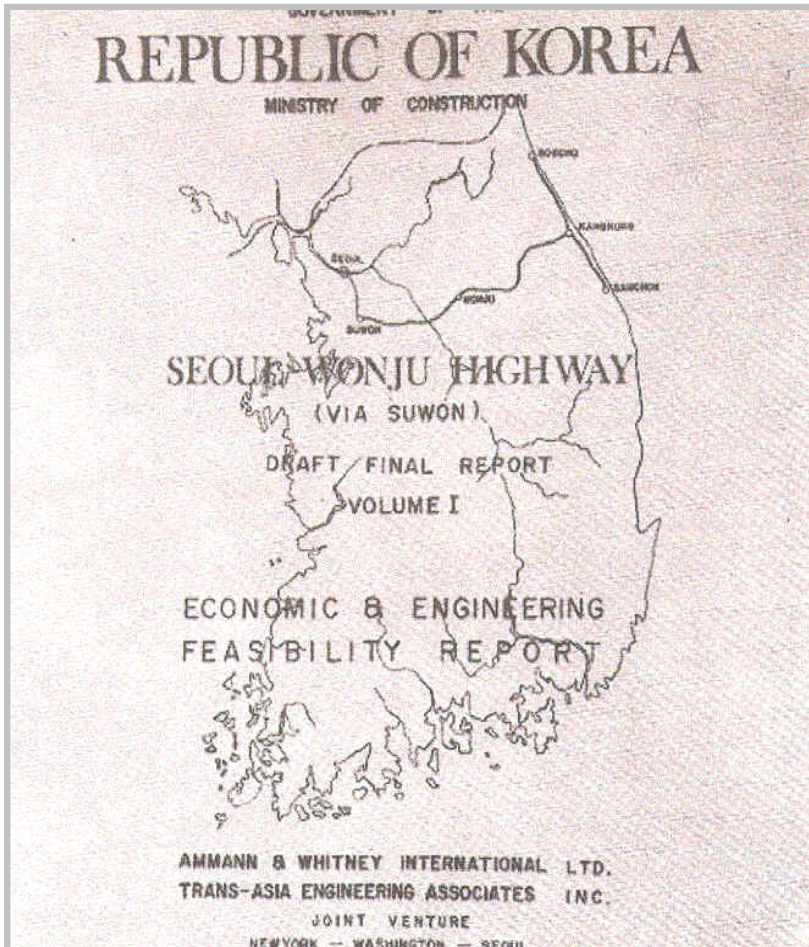

Project Description

The project is to improve the highway connection between Seoul and Wonju, Korea under the auspices of the Ministry of Construction with financial assistance by the International Development Association (IDA). This study is made in Korea by a team of thirteen experts provided by the joint venture and supported by counterpart staff provided by the Government. The study recommends the pavement and realignment of a two-lane highway via Suwon with a total length of 100 kms including 27 bridges, at projected construction cost of US\$ 24.5 million.
