Project Description

The Purefoods Flour Mill Expansion Project consisted of a Mill Building, a Warehouse, and other exterior facilities. Also included was the construction of a 2,000 kV standby generating set and construction of three (3) additional cylindrical silos. The Project is located in the Municipality of Mabini, province of Batangas.

The Mill Building is a six (6) storey structure which houses the production of pollard flour. The new warehouse building with an approximate area of 3,864 square meters was designed to utilize storage of brand and pollard. Due to the increase in the capacity of the plant, additional three (3) cylindrical silos were constructed to augment the storage capacity of wheat, including the construction of a 69 kV substation for the power supply requirements.

Scope of Services

As Construction Manager, Trans-Asia was involved in the pre-construction, construction and post-construction stages of the Project. The scope of works included the supervision of the structural, civil, electrical, mechanical, sanitary and architectural. Supervision on the installation of plant equipment was not included in Trans-Asia's scope of work.
