Project Description

SC-CA Multi-Purpose Hall is a development of five (5) storey multi-purpose building with 1,422 sq. meter per floor area. The ground floor and part of the second floor is designed to house the office of the Court of Appeal (spaces for book shelves, reading area and for their book rehabilitation). The second floor occupies their general services (Accounting and Budget Division), while the third and fourth floors are allocated for their parking area. The fifth floor is an exclusive playground for SC-CA staff only.

The Building is conservatively designed with clear-cut simple lines and conventional symmetrical masses similar to the existing building of SC-CA.
