**Project Description**

The Folk Arts Theatre, which forms, part of the Cultural Center Complex, is a huge covered amphitheatre overlooking Manila Bay on a parcel of reclaimed land along Roxas Boulevard. The project was built as the venue for Folkloric Arts and other activities with a seating capacity of 10,000. The structure is designed to provide the audience with a sweeping panorama of the center stage since the roof standing 15.5 meters high, is supported only by eight ( 8 ) massive.

Perimeter columns that created 80-meter clear spans inside the building. Air conditioned dressing rooms, located at each side of the stage accommodate up to 80 performers while the stage is framed on both sides with wood panels simulating the famous Philippine Nakar in lay.
